A display case was recently placed in the Lobby of the Perry County Sheriff's Office with booklets containing information about drugs.

The booklets, designed and distributed by "drugfreeworld.org", cover variety of information for public use and education. Some information contained in the booklets reference drug street names, what the drug is, short term and long term effects, statistics, why people take drugs and references.
