## WATER RESCUE OF MENTAL SUBJECT

On Sunday April 30th, at approximately 0723 hours, Officer Juhl, DQPD, discovered a suspicious vehicle parked in flood waters on Davisville Road near Cole Street. Officer Juhl notified the Sheriff's Office reporting a vehicle tied to a fence post and a male subject outside of the car acting suspicious.

Sheriff's Deputies, Du Quoin Police and Fire department, Benton Fire department, Pinckneyville EMS, and IDNR were also called to the scene due to flood conditions.

For over an hour, attempts were made to give the male subject verbal command but were unsuccessful. The individual continued to display erratic behavior. Emergency personnel then approached the male subject, made contact with him, and transported him to the Marshall Browning Hospital for evaluation.

The individual was identified as Phillip Morrison, 25, from Eldorado, IL.
